

Make an open door

Opening a door can be a symbol of welcoming someone into our homes and lives. This activity shows you how to make a welcome card.

You will need:

A sheet of paper or card of any size.

Pencils, pens, crayons or another way of making a message or picture.

Scissors (if you like).

How to make your card



Take your sheet of paper or card and fold each edge into the middle, creating two flaps that will be your 'doors'. You can cut the paper into rounded shapes to make the shape of your doors clearer – perhaps rounded or angled.

Inside the card, draw some things that would make you feel welcome in someone's house.

Or you can write a welcoming message.

Finally, why not pick out something from the Bible passage you heard today about Mary and her visit to Elizabeth. How might you express that with drawing or writing?

Be ready to share your card with everyone at the end of the service!
