

Ideas for Activities: 10th May 2020

Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?

John 14: 1-2

Jesus is preparing a place for us in God's house. What do you think God wants to make for us? What might it look like? What might it feel like?

Use some Lego or some other craft material to build a house or a room for you or someone else.

Thomas said to him, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, you will know my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him."

John 14: 5-7a

Jesus shows us what God the Father looks like. And he points the way towards Him. If we know Jesus and follow Him he will always lead us and never lose us.

To think about this you could make a needle compass and talk about how it will always point in the right direction (follow this link <https://www.wikihow.com/Make-a-Compass>).

If you have the materials (felt, thread, a marble), you could also sew a finger labyrinth. Help the marble along its way: it never gets lost and always reaches the end.
