Ephesians 4:1-7, 11-16

4I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord,
beg you to lead a life worthy of the
calling to which you have been
called, ²with all humility and gentleness,
with patience, bearing with one another
in love, ³making every effort to maintain
the unity of the Spirit in the bond of
peace. ⁴There is one body and one
Spirit, just as you were called to the one
hope of your calling, ⁵one Lord, one
faith, one baptism, ⁶one God and
Father of all, who is above all and
through all and in all.

7 But each of us was given grace
according to the measure of Christ's
gift. ¹¹The gifts he gave were that some
would be apostles, some prophets,
some evangelists, some pastors and
teachers, ¹²to equip the saints for the
work of ministry, for building up the
body of Christ, ¹³until all of us come to
the unity of the faith and of the
knowledge of the Son of God, to
maturity, to the measure of the full
stature of Christ. ¹⁴We must no longer
be children, tossed to and fro and
blown about by every wind of doctrine,
by people's trickery, by their craftiness

in deceitful scheming. ¹⁵But speaking
the truth in love, we must grow up in
every way into him who is the head,
into Christ, ¹⁶from whom the whole
body, joined and knitted together by
every ligament with which it is
equipped, as each part is working
properly, promotes the body's growth in
building itself up in love.

Mark 10:35-45

35 James and John, the sons of
Zebedee, came forward to him and said
to him, 'Teacher, we want you to do for
us whatever we ask of you.' ³⁶And he
said to them, 'What is it you want me to
do for you?' ³⁷And they said to him,
'Grant us to sit, one at your right hand
and one at your left, in your glory.' ³⁸But
Jesus said to them, 'You do not know
what you are asking. Are you able to
drink the cup that I drink, or be baptized
with the baptism that I am baptized
with?' ³⁹They replied, 'We are able.'
Then Jesus said to them, 'The cup that
I drink you will drink; and with the
baptism with which I am baptized, you
will be baptized; ⁴⁰but to sit at my right
hand or at my left is not mine to grant,
but it is for those for whom it has been
prepared.'

41 When the ten heard this, they began
to be angry with James and John. ⁴²So
Jesus called them and said to them,
'You know that among the Gentiles
those whom they recognize as their
rulers lord it over them, and their great
ones are tyrants over them. ⁴³But it is
not so among you; but whoever wishes
to become great among you must be
your servant, ⁴⁴and whoever wishes to
be first among you must be slave of
all. ⁴⁵For the Son of Man came not to

be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many.'
