Church Re-opening for Public Worship

The government has granted permission for public worship to recommence in church buildings. This is accompanied by a raft of regulations in order to minimise the risk of spreading the Covid-19 virus.

A record of who attends these services will be necessary to aid the government track and trace scheme, so please don't worry if we stand by the door requesting your name! The pattern of services offered will be updated and modified as government regulations change.

These services will also be zoomed for people who do not wish to attend in person, joining link via the website.
