





#### **Trumpington Community Orchard**

We have had an eventful summer. The meadow was replete with wildflowers and full of bees, butterflies and dragon flies. The heritage apple trees have all fruited this year, benefiting from the mulching in the spring, and the crab apple trees in the hedgerow have been laden with fruit. The single plum tree has also produced a bounty of plums and the quince tree too, though these have been mostly mistakenly picked by the public as pears so we may need some information labels next year. The habitat enhancement attempted with the felled old cherry trees in the thicket has proved a valuable pantry for the local robins and sparrows, as well as small mammals and reptiles. The most frequent visitors are an elegant muntjac, that lives in the neighbouring hazel platt, and a number of squirrels that have thankfully been kept off the swift tower, by the preventative measures taken in the spring. We are proud to report that we have had eight pairs of nesting swifts this year, again peacefully sharing with the local sparrows and it is quite amazing to see two pairs of parents taking turns to enter the nesting boxes to feed their offspring, with no squabbling at all. The swifts returned to Africa with their fledglings at the end of July and we look forward to their return next spring.

The next Orchard maintenance session will be at 11am on 10 December. Please note that we are now only running the maintenance sessions quarterly and hope this less frequent schedule will encourage more volunteers to attend. As always we provide gloves and necessary tools.

Finally, we would like to re-instate the moth day and bat walks if possible and are still looking for any moth or bat identification experts willing to run these events. Hope to see you soon. 




about the services they provide and find out more about the work of the Charity.












## Trumpington Repair Café


